## Room Intent

What are we working on this term and how can you support at home?

### Babies

- Physical Development- Moving and Handling  
crawling, cruising around furniture, and taking first steps

#### How to support at Home?

- Walking with the support of an adult can help improve your baby's confidence in walking. You can support your baby by holding their hands as they walk. Try holding their hands lower down rather than over their head. The best height to hold their hands is between your baby's waist and nipple.

### Infants

- Support behaviours and managing feelings appropriately.
- Building relationships with new children

#### Home Request

Please can you share family photos and current home interests to add to our 'Interest' key rings- By building on children's own interests we help children feel valued as an individual, whilst also building confidence to develop new relationships

### Toddlers

- Physical Development- Health and Self care  
Helps with dressing/undressing and care routines

#### How to support at Home?

- Choose the Right Clothing: Opt for clothes that are easy to put on and take off, such as those without complicated buttons or zippers. Avoid clothing that is too tight or restrictive, as comfort is key to encouraging self-dressing.
- Incorporate Play: Turn dressing into a game or a fun activity. Use songs or stories related to getting dressed to make the experience enjoyable.

W/c 16th Chinese New Year- Year of the Horse




17<sup>th</sup> Pancake Day- Pancake Day breakfast. Stay and enjoy a pancake with your child, finding your favourite toppings.
