Babies

- Physical Development- Health and Self care

Begin to feed self independently

How to support at Home?

- Mealtimes Together: Have your child eat with you during family meals. This encourages them to mimic your actions and learn through observation.
- Messy Play: Allow your child to explore food textures and flavours without pressure. Messiness is part of the learning process.
- Utensils: As your child progresses, introduce child-friendly utensils. Look for spoons and forks designed for small hands, which can help them practice

W/c 16th Chinese New Year- Year of the Horse




17th Pancake Day- Pancake Day breakfast. Stay and enjoy a pancake with your child, finding your favourite toppings.
